In Ephesians 5:15-17 Paul writes, "So be careful how you live. Don't live like fools, but like those who are wise. Make the most of every opportunity in these evil days. Don't act thoughtlessly, but understand what the Lord wants you to do." (NLT)

Even in the most rushed, overwhelming times of life, God is there, beckoning you to let Him into all that you're doing. Even in difficult relationships and too much work, God has wisdom and truth to impart to you.

By His power, you can take ownership of your life. And by His grace, you can walk wisely and make every moment a chance to see God's kingdom come both in your life and the lives of others. You have this power—not your own—living in you if you are a bornagain follower of Jesus. "God with us," who came to us as Jesus, left earth and sent "God in us" in the form of His Spirit. And that's actually better for us.

So, take time today to listen for the voice of God. Maybe you've been so busy lately that you haven't heard a thing He's been trying to say to you for quite some time. May we learn this Christmas season how to shed some baggage, shed some distractions, and travel a little lighter on this journey of life


